### School Administration Manager

Roosevelt Elementary is one of many schools in the district who has received a grant to fund the position for a School Administration Manager (SAM). Miss Monica Brumfield has been hired at Roosevelt as our new SAM. Miss Brumfield's, (or Miss B as the kids call her), primary role is to attend to the managerial functions in the building. This would include things such as student supervision, supervising non-instructional staff, ordering supplies, and serving as the first contact for student discipline and parent communications.
